
#### **Christmas Story Walk Returns**

#### Afghan Refugee Welcome

For several weeks now the Joplin community has been preparing for the arrival of 50 Afghanistan refugees that will resettle in our community. The first of these refugees arrived in Joplin just prior to Thanksgiving. As I have explained to our congregation on a few occasions, the efforts are being coordinated by R.A.I.S.E. (Refugee and Immigration Services & Education) based in Noel, MO. In November R.A.I.S.E. was granted office space at Crosslines Ministries in Joplin to provide a place of operation locally. In order for SJCC to determine how and to what extent we as a congregation are able to commit to these efforts in any fashion, R.A.I.S.E. has been invited to make a "Next Steps" presentation to our congregation on **Sunday, December 12 at 12:00 p.m.** This will be immediately at the conclusion of worship. We hope that many of you will be present to receive the information and ask questions. We must inform ourselves as to the magnitude of the task at hand and make our decision as a congregation based on that knowledge. Our decision cannot be made light-heartedly, as the needs of the refugees are complex and require many resources. Many thanks to the SJCC members who attended the Afghan Cultural Orientation at Christ Church of Oronogo on November 29.

#### "Friendsgiving" Food Donation

During our "Friendsgiving Dinner" last month members were provided the opportunity to bring non-perishable food items to share with others in our community. Many thanks were expressed by Souls Harbor for the donation of 43 assorted non-perishable items. They will provide food for the table in this time of scarcity. Thank you for your generosity.

#### **Board Meeting**

At its November 15 meeting, the board approved a 2022 proposed budget from the budget committee as well as a complete list of nominations for the slate of elected leadership, both of which will be presented to the congregation on December 5 for final vote.

Additionally, a motion was made and approved to hold quarterly in-person board meetings next year, with financial and committee reports provided monthly in email packets. The change does not impact the bylaws as they only stipulate "regular" meetings of the board. Special board meetings may still be called if needed.
