From Our Pastor

The journey of a thousand miles begins with one step, and we are officially one step forward on a journey that will lead us to a new location as a congregation. Following the congregational vote taken on May 22, a Relocation Task Force has been approved to begin the process of selling our property and finding a suitable location elsewhere in the area.

There are still more questions than there are answers, but those I have heard from are all optimistic and hopeful that this will be an energizing fresh start for us all. Undoubtedly we have mixed emotions along the way, and we will always treasure the memories we have made here. There will be losses along with the gains.

Please join me in praying for those who are appointed to the Relocation Task Force: Jim Cullumber (chair), Jessica Fletcher-Fierro, Mike Fitterling, Sam Knudtson, and Daniell Sanders. Darlene Coit as board chair and I are ex-officio to the task force. Along the way others will be asked to assist with areas of expertise, and the congregation will be provided with opportunities for additional input and, of course, sweat equity! Jim Michel with Church Extension will again be providing resources and knowledge from other congregations who have gone through similar relocation processes.

I'm also praying for the future occupants of this place, and for those who hold potential as our new neighbors. God knows us all.

Meanwhile, we have exciting new opportunities for ministry even before we relocate! The Outreach Ministry Team and our Elders have given the green light to partner with Disciples of Christ congregation, "The Connecting Grounds" in Springfield to launch a ministry to parents and foster children called Family Connection here in Joplin, to be hosted by SJCC. Parents with children in foster care are recommended by Family Services for supervised visits with their children, and Family Connection provides the safe location and trained volunteers to supervise the visits. Sandy Meadows has agreed to be our FC coordinator in charge of scheduling volunteers and accommodations. We will be sharing more details in the very near future, and offering the opportunity for SJCC people as well as community volunteers to help with this ministry of reunification and reconciliation through a variety of avenues. There is no need to wait until we are relocated, so we will begin as soon as we are trained and staffed.


