"Welcoming and accepting all people" – is a reminder of our Welcome Statement and genuine hospitality, in the present tense so it is always relevant. "*along*" – is an invitation to join together side by side. "*journey of faith*" – implies that arrival is a myth; we are always growing "*service*" –is a natural outcome of faith and inseparable from our commitment to discipleship.

LENTEN SEASON

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 22, and continues until Easter Sunday, April 9. Although we will be focused on the sale of the church and vacating the premises before March 31, it will be even more important to stay connected and focused on the foundation for our kinship, which is our God of Resurrection and Transformation! So we have chosen a Lenten theme we believe will provide meaningful worship while being minimally demanding in preparation and time commitment.



"Lookin' for Love" is the title of this year's theme, produced by Worship Design Studio. The description reads:

"The Christian scriptures offer many images of where love, grace, forgiveness, righteousness, and healing can REALLY be found. And it is not in the "usual" places. Isn't it as true of us today as it was of the scriptural authors? Don't we often look for wholeness and happiness in places that offer only temporary "good feelings" and satisfaction? Lent is a wonderfully reflective time to reassess where we are searching for meaning and purpose. We'll move through stories of Jesus to find out who offers the "real deal."

In addition to weekly Sunday worship scriptures and themes, devotional material will be provided for **Spiritual Life Groups** which will consist of optional small groups of people who meet periodically at their convenience to discuss responses to the topics and share prayer and faith stories. Look for a sign-up sheet in the narthex at PLC to participate.

Ash Wednesday — Looking for Love Joel 2:1-2, 12-17 and Matthew 6:1-6, 16-21 Week One — Look for the Resister Psalm 32 and Matthew 4:1-11 Week Two — Look for the Helper Psalm 121 and John 3:1-17 Week Three — Look for the Thirst-Quencher Exodus 17:1-7 and John 4:13-14 Week Four — Look for the Shepherd Psalm 23 and John 9:1-41 Week Five — Look for the Liberator Psalm 130 and John 11:1-45

Week Six — Look for the Unexpected Psalm 118:1-2, 19-29 and Matthew 21: 1-11

Holy Week — Love Looks for Us Psalm 116:1-2, 12-19 and John 13:1-17, 31b-35 Easter — Love Wins Jeremiah 31:1-6 and John 20:1-18

RELOCATION UPDATE

With the congregation's approval of the sale of 1901 S. Pearl, a lot needs to be done before we close on the sale March 31. We are retaining possession of the two rental homes and the adjacent half lot.

Our worship space at PLC is secure through May 9 as our board approved extending the rental agreement with Peace. Representatives from the Relocation Task Force and Church Board are meeting with Peace Lutheran representatives to discuss what a potential longer-term agreement might be.

In the meantime, the task force is looking diligently for other potential sites -- either to buy or lease, but working within our current finances. We likely will have interim office space, and will likely occupy one of the rental homes. We also need to locate storage space, and are working with Peace about possibly moving over our organ.

Ministry chairs have been asked to start going through remaining items in the church and determine what needs to be stored or what can be sold or trashed. The Board in February will discuss holding another rummage sale.

A final worship service is being planned for Sunday, February 19 at SJCC, but until that time we still have a few groups using the facilities and some scheduled events in Fellow-ship Hall, so please do not impede the use of the Fellowship Hall, kitchen, and other main areas in the process of clearing out rooms.
