April Worship – Easter and Earth



Documentary

Our outreach team has invested \$100 to co-sponsor a documentary being brought to Joplin by Kansas City University Medical School on April 5 and 6. The film *Cured* “illuminates a pivotal yet largely unknown chapter in the struggle for LGBTQ equality: the campaign that led the American Psychiatric Association (APA) to remove the diagnosis of homosexuality from its manual of mental illnesses.” (cureddocumentary.com)


