

#### **Interfaith Panel Discussion**

The Joplin Interfaith Coalition will host its next panel discussion on Saturday, January 25 at 10AM at the United Hebrew Congregation, 702 S. Seargeant. The topic is religious practices related to death and afterlife. Possible questions to be addressed by the various faith representatives are:

- Are there particular practices your religion follows regarding care and interment of the deceased?
- What are the main features of funerals in your religion?
- Are there particular mourning practices for the family of the deceased?
- How should members of your community show respect for the deceased and support their family?
- What are your teachings regarding what happens after death? Is there an afterlife, and how do we know about it?


Does your religion teach that there will be a resurrection of the dead?

#### **New Year, New Ways**

Many people resolve to start the new year by breaking unhealthy habits or learning healthier ones. Often these resolutions are for the benefit of personal wellbeing. But what if changing our practices could go beyond improving ourselves to actually helping others and the world? Kathy Escobar, author, spiritual director and copastor of a Denver congregation has written a book entitled *Practicing: Changing Yourself to Change the World* (©2020 Westminster John Knox Press). She highlights ten practices that followers of Christ can embrace that help us to live out our faith in tangible ways, contributing to the healing of all creation.

Over the coming eight weeks from Epiphany to the start of Lent, we will be using Kathy's book as a springboard for our Sunday morning worship and providing suggested actions for those willing to "put skin in the game." Not all practices will resonate with everyone, but we hope God will be at work in at least one or more of the practices to help our congregation look and act more like the Christ we profess to each other and our community.
