

- Plans are underway to relocate the Sojourners chancel furniture from storage into the church before the start of Lent, moving the Peace furniture temporarily into the classroom off the sanctuary until a new home has been found;
- · Using a section of the room off the sanctuary for pastors' offices;
- · Led by Jeanie Morrison, efforts are underway to empty the Sojourners storage unit;
